Parties:

A party request form must be filled out for all parties. You can get this form from the Pool Manager in the office. All dates must be approved ahead of time by Anna.

There is a \$50.00 deposit required to hold your date for the party, which must be received before the requested date. The deposit will be returned at the end of the party if the area is properly cleaned when you finish (supplies available for cleaning from the office).

There is no set area for parties and all tables are on a first come, first serve basis. Guest Fees apply for all parties.

If you wish to host a party after hours the above rules apply. If the party goes past 8:45pm an additional \$25.00 per hour, per lifeguard will be charged. For more details, please contact Anna at: huntingtonpool@gmail.com (C: 630-355-3344)

Guest Fees:

- \$5.00 for Adults, 18 & Older
- \$3.00 for Kids 5 to 17
- Out of (630) Area Code visitors are free.
- During any open pool sponsored social event the fees will be double. \$6 per child and \$10 per adult and party fees apply to all. For Social Events that close the pool, guest fees will be determined by Social and/or the Board.

Pool Rules:

No Glass Ordinance

At no time should anyone bring any type of glass container onto the pool grounds. A DuPage County ordinance requires the entire pool to be drained, checked and refilled should any glass be broken anywhere in the fenced area. Not only would this be a costly proposition, but would also create a safety hazard for our families and potentially take away from our swimming time. Please remember not to bring anything in a glass bottle (beer, wine), jar (pickles or any condiments), or any serving dish.

Periodically, the life guards will ask to check coolers or bags to ensure compliance of this important rule, so please do cooperate with them. If glass is found they will hold it in the office till your departure or until it is transferred to another non-glass container.

Ages:

- Kids ages 13 and older can be at the pool at any time without being accompanied by an adult, unless issues arise.
- Kids ages 9 and older can be at the pool until 7pm, after 7pm they must be accompanied by an adult or babysitter.
- Kids ages 8 and younger must be accompanied by an adult or babysitter at all times.

Pool Activities

- Adults Only Swim and Social: Adults only are invited to come out every Sunday (and Holidays) from 10:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M., for socializing, swimming and water volleyball. No sign up is necessary -- just come and enjoy the pool without the children.
- Ladies' Day: Mom & Kids Swim (kids must be accompanied by an adult) (9 & under) – Wednesdays 10:30am – 12:30pm
- Special Pre-School Time in the Baby Pool: The baby pool will be available for parents and their children, ages 4 and under, from 11:00 A.M. to 12:30 P.M. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays in June and July. Children must be supervised, as there will be no lifeguard on duty.

- Special Summer Social Events: Refer to the Social Events schedule (Page 3) and watch the bulletin board & future flyers for further information on these social events.

Grill Rules:

The grills are on a first come first serve basis. The big grill requires charcoal, lighter fluid & a lighter/matches. The pool does not supply these. There is a gas grill that is supplied with gas. If the gas runs out, there is normally a replacement tank in the office.

Refrigerator Rules:

The refrigerator in the back shed is free for all to use. It will be cleaned out every Friday and all foods will be thrown away. Please take all Tupperware home with you so it does not get thrown away. The pool is not responsible if someone else takes anything belonging to you that is left in the fridge.

Swim Lesson information

How to Register: Only active members who have paid their annual dues may register. Parents may register their child at the pool after Memorial Day. Students will be assigned to classes based on information provided by parents and/or conducting a brief water test.

Number in class: Sign-up is first come first served. Group lessons will be scheduled with three to six students per instructor. Additional students registered will be added to a "Waiting List." Private lessons are also available allowing students to work on whatever level of instruction desired (arrange dates and times directly with Anna.

Ages: Classes are offered for ages four (4) and up. A parent-tot class for ages 4 and under will be offered on Wednesdays. A three year-old child may take the older level class if they successfully participate in pre-school or some other type of organized learning environment and socialize well into a class on the 1st day.

Fees: Group lessons cost \$60.00 per student for eight half-hour lessons and session 5 is \$30.00 per child. No spots can be held in a class until the fee is paid. For more information call Swim Lesson Supervisor, Anna Martinkus, 630-849-6559 or email: acmartinkus@gmail.com

General Rules

- All members and guests are expected to comply with the established rules and regulations. They have been established to ensure safe and orderly operation of the pool and thereby ensure that all will receive the greatest benefits of the use of the facility.
- The pool management and staff are charged with the enforcement of these rules and regulations. The pool manager is authorized to establish temporary action when necessary.
- Pool management and staff should not be interfered with or reprimanded by members of the Club. Suggestions or complaints should be made in writing, stating facts briefly, and turned in to the pool office.
- Members and guests use the Club facilities at their own risk. The Club is not responsible for the destruction, theft, loss or damage to the property of any member or guest.
- Any property of the Club broken or damaged by a member or his guest shall be paid for by the member.
- Admission to the use of the Club's facilities will be permitted only by checking in at the front desk of the pool. Only members in good standing (fees paid in full) will be allowed entrance to the pool. The guard at the desk shall be provided with a list of all members and their addresses to ensure only authorized use of the pool.
- Any member who willfully permits the use of his name by an unauthorized person will be subject to a loss of privileges for ten (10) days. Repeated violations may result in the termination of membership.

- Children under twelve years of age will not be admitted or permitted to remain after 7:00 P.M. unless accompanied and supervised by a responsible person 18 years old or over.
- Children under the age of nine (9) must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible person at all times.
- Only children ages 4 and under will be permitted in the baby pool under the supervision of a parent or other responsible adult.
- Children (ages 17 and under) will only be allowed in the adult area when supervised by their parents.
- Members and their guests are expected to conduct themselves in a respectable manner. Profane or abusive language, lewd or obscene behavior, rowdyism and hazardous conduct will not be tolerated. Club privileges can be suspended.
- All swimmers under the age of 18 will be subject to an enforced rest period of ten to fifteen minutes every hour, as determined by the guard(s) on duty.
- Parties of ten or more should provide two weeks notice to the pool office to ensure a sufficient number of guards are available.

Guests

- Maintenance members are not allowed to attend as guests.
- Guest fees for persons under 17 years of age are \$3.00 per day. Guest fees for adults (persons 18 years of age and older) are \$5.00 per day. Guests must register and pay prior to admission to the pool.

- Out of town house guests or relatives staying overnight at your home (or local Hotel) will be able to use the pool, volleyball court, or tennis courts at no charge, when accompanied by pool member.
- A guest must abide by pool rules and regulations.
- At the pool manager's discretion, guests may be refused admission. Excessive use of guest privileges will be addressed as deemed appropriate by the board of directors.
- Baby-sitters may bring member's children to pool.

Grounds

- Parking of automobiles is permitted in the parking area. Parking in the emergency area is prohibited. The Club disclaims any liability for the theft of any automobile or for the damage to any automobile.
- The Club does not provide parking attendants and no employee shall be required or permitted to drive or park the automobile for a member or guest.
- Dogs, cats or pets are not permitted in the Club House or on the pool grounds.
- No smoking in the bath house or pool area. **This is a DuPage County Health Department Law.** Smoking is only permitted in the adult area adjacent to the pool deck during Adult Sunday Swim time (10 am to 12 noon) and Adult only Social Events
- Food and beverages are prohibited in the pool area **by order of the DuPage County Health Department.** Confine such activities to the refreshment areas located at the vending machines or in the adult section. All refuse should be placed in the containers provided. **Glass of any type is**

strictly prohibited. No chewing gum will be allowed.

- Club employees shall not be sent out of the Club grounds by members.
- No notice, sign, decoration or picture shall be posted any place in the Club House except with the approval of the manager. Notices must be located on bulletin boards.
- All bicycles are to be kept outside at or near the bicycle rack.
- Only clean footwear, baby strollers or wheelchairs are allowed in the pool area or bath house.

Health

- All persons are encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool.
- Any person having communicable diseases, infections or open wounds will be denied admission to the pool. Any person with an open wound should report to the pool manager for admission to the pool.
- Wearing apparel, other than swim wear, will not be allowed in the pool area except during swim meets, other special occasions when the pool is closed to open swimming, or under a particular approved circumstance. No cut-offs or shorts of any kind!!!
- Suntan oil must be removed by showering before entering the pool. (Baby oil also.)
- Spitting, spouting water from the mouth, or blowing your nose in the water is strictly forbidden.
- Swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained. Disposable or cloth diapers are not

allowed in the pool area. (Health Department Requirement)

Safety

- Swimmers must be able to swim the length of the pool before being allowed to swim in the deep area. Children unable to meet the above requirement will be allowed in the deep end if there is a parent, or supervising adult, in the deep end of the pool accompanying the child. If the guards are in doubt, any swimmer may be asked to demonstrate this ability. The guard's decision should not be questioned.
- Glass containers will not be allowed in or around the pool areas.
- Facemasks will not be allowed in the pool at the discretion of the manager or person in charge at the time.
- No snorkels, rafts, inner tubes or toys are allowed in the pool, with the exception of sponge balls (at the discretion of the lifeguards).
- No one will be permitted in the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- There will be no running, pushing, dunking or ball games in the pool area.
- Only one person at a time will be allowed on the board. Each diver must be certain the diving area is clear before diving from the board. Finally, the diver must swim immediately to the pool edge, ladder or shallow end of the pool after surfacing.
- Passing on the board, diving or jumping on the edge, hand stands, hanging on the hands, springing

from a sitting position or bouncing more than once are prohibited.

- Diving is permitted in the diving well area of the pool only. No inward or reverse dives are permitted.

Tennis Rules and Regulations

- All players must wear tennis shoes.
- Children and adults not playing tennis must remain outside of the fence. There will be a maximum of four (4) players per tennis court.
- Junior players (under 16 years of age) must give adults court preference at all times on Saturdays, Sundays, holidays and on weekdays after 5:00 P.M. However, on said days, if a court is open, a Junior may play with the understanding of the adult priority. Children are permitted to play with their parents at all times.
- Only those members age 16 and above will be allowed to schedule court time. Please refer to the pool office for more details.
- Court time is limited to one (1) hour per day per family.
- All players, including guests, must sign at the office before playing tennis.
- All tennis complaints are to be made to the manager of the pool.
- Courtesy is requested when crossing another court to get to your assigned court. Wait quietly at the side until the point is completed and then hurry across. This is also the case when chasing a ball. Wait until play is completed and then ask if they will retrieve your ball or give you permission to do so.

- Vacate the court at the end of your hour or as quickly as possible to prevent a delay of the players waiting to come on the court.
- Pick up all articles brought onto the court. This includes tennis balls, cans and tops, as well as trash.
- There is no bike riding, roller blading, skating, skateboarding, baseball, etc., allowed on the courts. Parents will be held responsible for damage to the courts by their children.

Tennis Court Reservations

- Rights to the tennis courts will be determined by court reservations for the time span of May 24 thru September 1.
- Prior to the official opening date, and after the official closing date, the courts will be open as weather permits. Use is limited to members only and is on a *first come, first served* basis. Courts change on the hour regardless of how long players have occupied the courts.
- Court reservations can be made either by phone or personal contact with the Club Office. Club phone number is 630-355-3344.
- Court reservations are limited to one (1) hour per day per family.
- Reservations for court time can be made two (2) days in advance. Reservations will only be accepted during the regular pool hours.
- Reservations must be made by those members intending to use the court. Members may not use another member's name to reserve a court.

- Cancellation of reserved court time will be accepted any time before reserved tennis time at the Club Office.
- Reservations for courts will be held only five (5) minutes after the hour.
- During scheduled group lessons the courts are not available for advance reservations – please see office for the schedule.

Tennis Guests

- Guests must register at the Club Office and pay a \$3.00 guest fee for children under 18 and a \$5.00 guest fee for adults.
- If a pool member is receiving private tennis instruction from a non-member instructor, the instructor must pay the required guest fee.

“Beach” Volleyball Guests

- Guests must register at the Club Office and pay a \$3.00 guest fee for children under 18 and a \$5.00 guest fee for adults.
- A Club member must sign out the volleyball in the Club Office and will be held responsible for the ball's return.
- All volleyball players must completely rinse/shower their feet of all sand before returning to the pool area.

Membership Dues:

- Active Equity Members: \$450 - For bondholders who want daily access to the Club's facilities in season.
- Maintenance Equity Members: \$195 - For bondholders who decide not to be active 2012 pool members, but want to keep their pool bond up to date. Maintenance members can register for and attend social events for an additional fee.
- Bond purchase cost (from the pool): \$1,000
- Annual members: \$595 – for non-bondholders who are interested in daily access to the club's facilities in season. This is for one year only and 2015 annual members will be required to acquire a bond in 2015 to use the pool's facilities.

Incentives: (for 2016 Season only)

- Open House – May 31th through June 7th for families that would like to try out the pool at the beginning of the season
