Dear Members,

With the sun breaking through the grey clouds, I hope the entire club is anticipating the return of summer. Your volunteer board has been working hard on plans for the Summer of 2010, including an exciting social calendar!

Last summer, with the help of many individuals, we were able to make some great improvements to the pool. As the pool property gets older, however, some improvements become a little more costly. The pool is now 40 years old, and anyone who has reached that milestone realizes that a little maintenance may be needed now and then. That said, we are reviewing several additional repairs or improvements to the pool that are going to be necessary to keep the pool going strong into the future. Some of the more major repair items are fixing a crack in the pool, which also then requires repainting, and resurfacing the tennis courts. There are also some additional improvements we would like to make to increase everyone's enjoyment of the pool, including new tables and chairs for the pool deck.

Unfortunately, with the increase in costs for operating the pool, we are not able to make all the repairs and improvements we would like without asking for some additional help from our members. For this reason, we have been considering the possibility of a Special Assessment for our equity members. At this time, we are hoping to avoid this option, but with the upcoming repairs that may be required for the pool and courts, it may become necessary.

To get further input on this issue, we are planning to distribute a brief survey via email in the coming weeks – please make sure we have your correct email address. On the survey, we would like you to provide your thoughts on this assessment. Specifically, we would like to gather additional information from you about what you would like to see happen at the pool from an improvement standpoint, and what we can do to get that accomplished. This can assist us in determining what level of assessment would best fit the needs of our members.

Last year's 1<sup>st</sup> Maintenance Day was sparsely attended but highly productive (probably because it was Mother's Day weekend, so we have changed the dates this year), and the second Maintenance Day was a great success. This year's **Maintenance days are scheduled for 10-2 pm April 24<sup>th</sup> and May 15<sup>th</sup>**. We will focus on "outside tasks" for the early Maintenance Day, "inside jobs" for the latter. Please mark your calendar and bring your garage brooms, shovels, rakes, toolbox or whatever. Pizza will be provided.

**2010 Fees:**

Membership fees for 2010 are below:

Active Equity Members: \$450 - For bondholders who want daily access to the Club's facilities in season.

Maintenance Equity Members: \$195 - For bondholders who decide not to be active 2010 pool members, but want to keep their pool bond up to date. Maintenance members can register for and attend social events for an additional fee.

Bond purchase cost (from the pool): \$1,000

Annual members: \$595 – for non-bondholders who are interested in daily access to the club's facilities in season. This is for one year only and 2010 annual members will be required to acquire a bond in 2011 to use the pool's facilities.

Please note that membership payments must be postmarked by 5/1/10 or an additional \$50 late fee will be required. In addition, all fees must be paid in full before the beginning of your pool season.

**Board appointments:**

The Board appointment will take place at the annual open meeting of our club, which will be 7:30-8 pm April 26, 2010 at Prairie School 500 S. Charles St; Naperville immediately following Swim Team Registration.
